

# NORTH CHELMSFORD FROM THE AIR



The center of North Chelmsford around the common is shown in this air view showing the following key locations: (1) North Chelmsford town hall; (2) the Princeton schools; (3) the common; (4) North Chelmsford fire station; (5) Vinal square; (6) the Merrimack river; (7) the Congregational church; (8) the Southwell Wool Combing mill. The arrow on the upper left indicates the road to Westford, while the arrow at the top shows the

road to Tyngsboro and points north; the arrow on the right marks Middlesex street, the road leading to Lowell, and the arrow at the bottom indicates the road leading to North Chelmsford and Boston. The two-headed arrows indicate the Boston and Maine tracks running north and south through the town. Pilot of the plane was George Thomopoulos of the Reebal Flying Service, Richardson airfield, Dracut.
