HELD IN \$1000 BAIL

Owner of Chelmsford, Farm Raided Last Week to Have Hearing September 23

Joseph Tremblay of Tadmuck road, Chelmsford, was arraigned this morning before United States Commissioner Richard Brabrook Walsh, charged with illegally possessing and manufacturing liquor, the charge resulting from the raid made upon his premises early Friday morning in which a huge still and other material for the manufacture of liquor was seized.
